# **BACKGROUND**

Population \* **Paraguay** \_ 7 152 703

Estimates indicate that the cancer burden is likely to double by 2040

The Ministry of Health in Paraguay has been working to have better cancer data for cancer control planning.

As a GICR Partner Country, Paraguay has committed to advance in the establishment of a Population Based Cancer Registry (PBCR) in Asunción, the capital city. GICR will provide the necessary technical assistance (training, advice, others) via the IARC Regional Hub for Latin America.



#### **AIMS**

- Implementation of the population-based cancer registry of Asunción, covering a population of **2 665 000** persons
- Obtaining the first recorded data on cancer in Asunción



## **OUTCOMES**

- Standard cancer incidence report in 2023
- Local cancer data disseminated and communicated to stakeholders



#### **IMPACT**

- Ensuring local cancer data for evidence-based cancer control planning and evaluation
- Motivating cancer research with local data
